Showmanship Goat Show:

A-21 YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP - Novice 10 and under with any fiber goat

A-22 YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP - Junior 11-13 years with any fiber goat

A-23 YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP - Senior 14-17 years with any fiber goat

A-24 ADULT SHOWMANSHIP - 18 years and older with any fiber goat.

Specialty Colored Angora Goat Show Classes:

All entered goats must have been shown in their individual classes.

SP-1 "Get of Sire"-from the same farm, 3 animals, any age/gender, having the same sire consistency in fleece and confirmation

SP-2 "Small Flock"-one buck and two does of any age, from the same farm, showing consistency in fleece and confirmation

SP-3 "Best Fleece on Animal"-the best-judged fleece (only) in the ring, any age, any gender

SP-4 "Dam & Daughter"-The BEST judged dam and daughter in the ring often showing the improvement from one generation to the next

SP-5 "Pair of Yearlings"-Two Yearlings (any gender, age, relationship) from the same herd, on the same farm, showing consistency

Other Information:

- Refer to "regulations and other information" for information on bedding and pens.
- Any class change must be made before 6:00 pm on Friday, June 7th. Show management reserves the right to combine classes.
- Polled angoras will not be accepted.
- All goats must have premise identification ear tags that comply with the National Scrapie Eradication Program **ATTACHED TO THE ANIMAL**.
- Call 866-873-2824 for help with tags (USDA).
